Over the last two years Astilleros de Mallorca has been working on a programme to update the yard, including a complete overhaul and uprating of the four slipways to increase their capacity.

The season ending in July 2001 recorded an all-time high in yard occupation. Work was varied, as in all recent years, ranging from routine checks and annual maintenance to large-scale refits, such as the lengthening of the 44 meter yacht SHARK and the complete renewal of its living quarters, electrical machinery systems, etc. In between these two extremes

came countless specific projects tailor-made to suit each particular vessel, adding up to a total of 120 individual projects in the last year. To be able to meet the demands of all these varied jobs the yard boasts a whole host of specialized workshops to complement its traditional activity. Our proven in-house capacity now includes full machinery workshop, the manufacture of stainless steel fittings, steel and aluminum workshops, a piping workshop, deck carpentry, interior carpentry, rigging workshops, electrical and electronics, painting and upholstery.

New Hydroblasting machine



Our new hydro blasting machine with a working pressure of 2000 bars and two simultaneous jet nozzles has allowed us to phase out the old sandblasting machines and carry out far more precise work as well as be more friendly to the environment.

BECAUSE EACH YACHT IS DIFFERENT

After years of experience in yacht repairs and refits, many different projects have by now passed through our hands. These always involve a detailed study of the particular features of each yacht, due attention being paid to the owner's desire for a unique vessel. Examples of the specialised work we take in our stride are:



Steel hull extension for M/y Shark. The old stern was completely removed and replaced with new extension for extended lazarette and machinery space.



Rigs, both high-tec and classic, are continually serviced in our designated area, including annual checks, painting, modification and even complete rig replacement.



Swim platform extension on this aluminum motor yacht included extension of the topside aft quarters to maintain the yacht's sleek lines.



Addition of bulbous bow greatly improved the ride and sea keeping qualities of this 48meter steel motor yacht.



Total reconstruction and renewal of living quarters and facilities of the classic M/y Babatte, originally built in Fairmile Shipyard in England. The Colonial style was maintained throughout and externally a small sundeck was added.

Teak deck repairs and replacement, incorporating both traditional techniques and the latest in pre-fabricated deck sections, dramatically cutting down installation time.



Galley redesign and modification to incorporate new appliances finished with Corian and stainless steel custom cabinets, all made on site.



Topside repainting carried out under custom shrink foil covers protecting both the working area and the environment.



Complete interior renewal for both crew and guest quarters onboard M/y Jamaica Bay.



Full or partial engine and machinery servicing and overhauls, which in some cases involves the complete removal of the units from the yacht.



Addition of a new jacuzzi in sundeck redesign. In this case pipe work had to be incorporated in to the existing structure.



Wooden hull repair and maintenance, here involving replacement of part of the keel section and stern post.
