

COOKIE AND LOCAL STORAGE POLICY

Cookie Policy:

According to Law 34/2002, of July 11, on Information Society Services and Electronic Commerce, we inform you that this website uses Cookies to improve and optimize the user experience. Below you will find detailed information about what "Cookies" are, what type this website uses, how to change your cookie settings, and what happens if you disable them.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when you access certain web pages. Cookies allow a web page, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or their equipment and, depending on the information they contain and the way you use your equipment, they can be used to recognize the user.

What types of cookies does this website use?

- **Depending on the entity that manages them, cookies can be:**

- **Own cookies:** These are those that are sent to the interested party's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
- **Third-party cookies:** These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.

- **Depending on the length of time they remain activated:**

- **Session cookies:** These are a type of cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that is only of interest to keep for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion (e.g., a list of purchased products).
- **Persistent cookies:** These are a type of cookie in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.

- **For what purposes can the website's cookies be used?**

- **Technical cookies:** These are those that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform, or application and use the different options or services that exist in it, such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing restricted access parts, remembering the elements that make up an order, carrying out the purchase process of an order, making the request for registration or participation in an event, using security elements during navigation, storing content for the dissemination of videos or sound, or sharing content through social networks.
- **Personalization cookies:** These are those that allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics based on a series of criteria in the user's terminal, such as the language, the type of browser through which they access the service, the regional configuration from where they access the service, etc.
- **Analysis cookies:** These are those that allow the person responsible for them to monitor and analyze the behavior of the users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the websites, application, or platform and for the elaboration of navigation profiles of the users of said sites, applications, and platforms, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the usage data made by the users of the service.

- **Advertising cookies:** These are those that allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included in a web page, application, or platform from which the requested service is provided based on criteria such as the edited content or the frequency in which the advertisements are shown.
- **Behavioral advertising cookies:** These are those that allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included in a web page, application, or platform from which the requested service is provided. These cookies store information on the behavior of users obtained through continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows developing a specific profile to display advertising based on it.
- **Own cookies**

Are there only cookies?

There may be websites that use other forms of storage similar to cookies but with more capacity, such as other forms of local data storage on the client's equipment, for example:

- HTML5 LocalStorage and sessionStorage: Space that the web can use on the user's equipment. Normally, deleting the Browsing history can delete them.
- Flash "Local Shared Objects" (Silverlight's "isolated storage"): They are stored inside the Microsoft folder where you have the user profile. You have to enter the folder and delete it. (Example: Vimeo videos). Flash is used to incorporate multimedia elements into a website, and to do this, it stores files on the user's equipment.
- The web beacon is used to track your activity, inserting a mini-image that you do not even notice. When you browse the web, it loads along with the page, and the server from which the photo is downloaded records the time of access, or the times you have accessed it.

These files are more intrusive than cookies, since they are more complicated to delete, store more information, and are independent of the browser used. We do not use this type of storage.
